

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS
CALLISBURG INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT'S
State Financial Accountability Rating**

**Callisburg will hold a public meeting
at 6:00 P.M., October 18, 2007
in the Callisburg High School Library
Callisburg, Texas.**

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss Callisburg ISD's rating on the state financial accountability system.

This is the fifth year of Schools FIRST (Financial Accountability Rating System of Texas), a financial accountability system for Texas school districts developed by the Texas Education Agency in response to Senate Bill 875 in 1999. The primary goal of School FIRST is to achieve quality performance in the management of school district's financial resources, a goal made more significant due to the complexity of accounting associated with Texas school finance system.

The Schools FIRST accountability rating system assigns one of four financial accountability ratings to Texas school districts, with the highest being Superior Achievement. Our district has received the highest rating (Superior Achievement) for financial accountability five years in a row.
